## CBT priorities

Good transport policies can improve people's lives and reduce damage to our environment. The three core policies are:-

### Improve public transport

Public transport must be made comfortable, affordable, convenient and accessible. Pedestrian and cycle routes must be made safe and convenient.

Access to jobs, services, friends and family: transport must help us make these connections, and be sure to include our most vulnerable citizens.

### Reduce traffic

People deserve attractive streets where children can play, neighbours can meet, and pedestrians and cyclists travel safely and

in comfort.

Road-building cannot solve congestion, but good planning can by making homes, shops, workplaces and leisure facilities closer, reducing the need to travel.

## Tackle climate change

Urgent action is needed to reduce transport's contribution to climate change: right now, CO2 emissions from transport are rising in the UK.

Businesses need easy and attractive sustainable travel choices for their goods and their employees.

## Campaigns

**Save Our Buses** is a new campaign to stand up for treasured local buses and to defend them from damaging funding cuts.

**Roads to Nowhere** As transport budgets are tightened CBT are calling for greener, cheaper alternatives to road building.

**Fair Fares Now** is the campaign for cheaper, simpler, fairer train fares
